

## Sampling Instructions for the Easy Collect Fabric Meat Sampler

## Follow these instructions to collect a sample from a bin of beef trim using the Easy Collect sampler:

- 1. Label the bag of the Easy Collect Sampler with the appropriate lot information.
- 2. Setup your sampling area on a clean, sanitized surface.
- 3. Put on plastic apron (optional) and sleeves and apply sanitizer to each.
- 4. Remove the bin cover by gathering it to one side, exposing the trim.
- 5. Sanitize the stopwatch needed for timing the sampling.
- 6. Remove the perforated top of the bag and put on Nitrile or a similar type of glove. If not sterile, apply sanitizer.
- 7. Remove the sampler from the bag and place it onto the surface of the trim.
- 8. Fold the bag and place it in the pocket of the apron or other clean surface.
- 9. Unfold the sampler and place it onto the trim so that it remains flat.
- 10. Start the timer to countdown 1 minute 30 seconds.
- 11. Grab the Easy Collect sampler with both hands and begin rubbing the trim on half of the bin.
  - a. Do this for 45 seconds using one side.
  - b. Trim that has been sampled can be moved to the side to expose other trim. This can be done by pushing or grabbing trim with the cloth.
  - Rub the trim with a significant amount of pressure using the entire surface area on one side of the sampler, forcing the sampler between and below pieces of trim.
  - d. The entire side of the sampler should be covered with meat and fat.
- 12. After 45 seconds, and sampling one-half of the bin, flip the sampler to the other side and begin rubbing the other half of the bin for 45 seconds.
- 13. Fold the sampler and place it back into the sample bag.
- 14. Remove gloves by grasping from the edge of the glove. Roll the top of the bag on itself a couple of times and fold the wire tabs to secure the bag.
- 15. Place the labeled bag into a cooler with ice packs.
- 16. Submit the samples to the laboratory.
